Low-Cal Reuben

Dijon mustard
2 slices rye bread
1 (1-ounce) slice reduced-fat, reduced-sodium Swiss cheese (such as Alpine Lace)
2 ounces smoked turkey, thinly sliced
2 1/2 T. sauerkraut, drained and rinsed
1 T. fat-free Thousand Island dressing
1 1/2 tsp. canola oil



Spread about 3/4 teaspoon mustard over each bread slice. Place 1 cheese slice on each of 4 bread slices. Divide turkey evenly over cheese. Top each serving with 2 1/2 tablespoons sauerkraut and 1 tablespoon dressing. Top each serving with 1 bread slice, mustard sides down.

Heat 1 1/2 teaspoons canola oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Add 2 sandwiches to pan; top with another heavy skillet. Cook 3 minutes on each side or until golden.

ATA Tips **E-TIPS FOR THE JOB HUNT**

When searching for a job, you need to consider how you conduct yourself online.

1. Use smart subject lines in emails.
2. Use a signature file.
3. Think before you hit send (spellcheck, avoid fancy fonts, rainbow colors, smiley faces).
4. Be careful when posting to online forums.
5. Don't be too informal when communicating online (ex. writing in all lowercase, addressing by first name).
6. Don't instant message when you should call.
7. Don't build junk online. Think about what a potential employer will find when he/she Googles you.

8. Don't bad-mouth employers online, even if you think you're posting anonymously.

9. Make sure your email address is appropriate, nothing vulgar or immature.
